# **CHECKLISTS**

### Format:

- electronic use
- ready-to-print, if a hard copy is needed
- reading & writing, math, science, PE, health, social studies, technology, arts, & computer science

The checklists make it easier to analyze existing units or assessments, for planning, or any task that involves accessing the standards quickly.



# **CARD STRIPS**

#### Format:

- one standard on each card strip, ready-to-print
- domain, cluster, and code included with each standard
- color coordinated by domain
- reading & writing, math, & social studies

The card strips are perfect as hands-on manipulatives for sorting standards or planning cross-curricular work. Suggestions are included for easy ways to use the card strips with students, as well.



# **SORTABLE DATABASE**

# Format:

- standard with the domain, cluster, and code
- reading & writing, math, science, PE, health, social studies, technology, arts, & computer science
- Excel

The spreadsheets make it easier to organize standards for lesson planning, reviewing units, and creating assessments.



# **COMPARISON**

#### Format:

- two column comparison of old standards and new standards
- domain, cluster, and code included
- reading & writing, and math

The comparison document allows for identifying and understanding the changes in the standards.
